Provincial Grand Lodge 100 Club Rules & Regulations

- 1. The subscription to the 100 Club for one number is £12 per year payable annually in advance. This will provide members with one number with their number being in 4 draws (i.e. cost is £1.00 per month). Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
- 2. Lodges, Members, Family & Friends over 16 years of age can become a member of the 100 Club and you are encouraged to get family & friends to join. The 100 Club will not be limited to 100 members. The more members/numbers taken, the bigger the quarterly Draw prizes!
- **3.** There is no provision to opt in/out on a month by month basis. The normal 100 Club year will be **1 July to 30 June.** Members joining after the start of the normal 100 Club membership year will be charged a pro-rata amount for the rest of the year until 30 June and entered into the next available Draw following payment.
- 4. There shall be three prizes per draw per quarter. The quarterly Draws are made in September, December, March & June.
- 5. A member is eligible for inclusion in the Draw as long as the subscription for that quarter has been paid.
- **6.** Each member is allocated a number in the quarterly Draw. This number shall remain the members provided their subscription is up to date.
- **7.** Members wishing to leave the 100 Club should do so at the end of the club membership year. Refunds will not be given for persons wishing to withdraw before the end of the Club year.
- 8. Quarterly prizes will be awarded according to membership of the 100 Club for that quarter as follows:
 - a. 50% of the quarter's net payments shall make-up the prize fund. (3 prizes each quarter).
 - b. The remaining 50% of the net payments will be allocated to the PGL BYSS Fund.
- 9. The allocation of numbers & Draw results will be available from Bro. Victor, Lord Denovan, Abbotsford Terrace, Darnick, TD6 9AD; Tel: 01896 820 222, or any other member of the PGL Committee. Updates will be placed on the PGL website. (www.pgltsb.co.uk)
- **10.** The 100 Club administrators will make all reasonable efforts to pay prizes to the winners within a reasonable period after each quarterly draw.
- 11. The decision of the PGL Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
- **12.** The PGL Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion providing such reasonable notice is given to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
- 13. Please either complete a download of the attached Bankers Order OR you can set-up a Standing Order online with the details of the PGL Sorting Code and Account Number as shown at bottom right of the Bankers Order Form. In all cases please inform the PGL Treasurer that you have completed this action in order that his records can be updated. Bro.
